



July 4 th, we will participate along with our cub scout pack, in the Hillsboro 4th of July Parade. Be part of the fun and come march with us, there is always room for one more.


August 12 th thru the 14 th, we will once again be at the North Plains Garlic Festival, with our corn cooker, roasting delicious ears of fresh local corn.



A photograph of the President inspecting the guard at Naval Base Pier 7 after he came ashore from the yacht Williamsburg appeared in the *Norfolk Virginian-Pilot* last Sunday. The picture was taken as he passed the local Marine, who recently was assigned to the Marine Barracks at Norfolk after returning from active duty in Korea, during which he was twice wounded and cited for gallantry.
